WHAT IS THE PROGRAM?



The Universidad Católica Boliviana "San Pablo" offers to international students the possibility to do an internship in Bolivia. The purpose of this project is to be able to offer the possibility for foreign students who come for a semester to strengthen their professional training through contact in a work environment, also the U.C.B. plans to offer a list of specific courses from which they can chose, this courses will help the students to understand better the work environment and the culture in Bolivia.



WHO IS THE COURSE FOR?

The course is directed to students who are almost finishing their studies at their home university and would like to put in practice what they have learned so far. Besides they have the opportunity to know more about the culture and practice Spanish in a Latin American context.

OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAM

- The program seeks to offer the opportunity to the students to have an international experience of work.
- Knowing other cultures and expands their knowledge in their fields.
- You can make an internship of 20 hours per week for one or two semester in one of the institutions with which we have an agreement.
- Take courses that help you complement your internship.
- Create a work plan that you will develop during your internship according to your and the companies expectative.
- •Flexibility in terms of schedules.



STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM



a) COURSES

The student, must be enroll on at least one academic course, this one could be from their field of study or a cultural one.

b) INTERNSHIP

The internship program for foreigners seeks to offer the student a complete exchange experience, by linking their academic background with knowledge of a new culture. To sign up for the program, the student must follow all the application process. In this one he will have the opportunity to choose the institution's he wishes to work, the selection will be made according to their interesting and field of study. Besides, the student will select the academic and cultural courses he will like to take during his time.

The acceptance of the internship will be done by the institution, the student will be informed through the international office of all the process.

c) CERTIFICATION

All the interns that complete their internship program will get a certificate from the institution. In this one it will be pointed out the total of work hours and the general task that has completed.

e) APPLICATION

- **Step 1.** The mobility coordinator of Partners University must send the following information: Student's name, application semester, study program, application semester and the student's email.
- Step 2. Fill in the online application form.
- **Step 3.** The U.C.B. will contact you to inform you of the status of your application and if there is no observation, the acceptance letters will be issued.

f) PREPARE FOR THE ARRIVAL

Once the student receives the acceptance letter, he can start preparing for the journal, for more information you can search in our web site.



FREE SPANISH COURSES

The U.C.B. offers free Spanish courses for foreign students. It is developed with an emphasis on learning the language through knowing the Bolivian culture. The course is twice a week making a total of 3 hours. Students that register to the course can get credits.

COURSES TO PROMOTE THE CULTURAL EXCHANGE

The U.C.B. offers, through the Department of Culture, cultural immersion classes that include trips to Bolivian cities and extracurricular activities (artistic expression workshops, folkloric ballet, tuna, choir and sports). The activities are held in different times and days. 


NATURAL AND CULTURAL WEALTH
